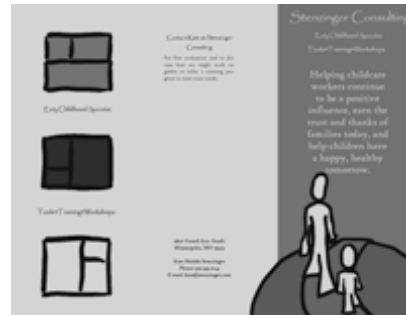

Mental Health in young children and infants
